


NORTH WEST ELEVATION
SCALE: 1/8" = 1'-0"




WEST ELEVATION
SCALE: 1/8" = 1'-0"




SECTION E-E
SCALE: 1/8" = 1'-0"




SOUTH EAST ELEVATION




EAST ELEVATION
